Tourism

Spain expects 2.4% revenue gain from visits

Spain's tourism industry will post a 2.4 percent gain in revenue this year, due to demand from vacationing Spaniards and Britons, said **Exceltur**, a trade group. The group expects 3.6 percent more British visitors this year and domestic demand will rise 5.4 percent, Exceltur said. Vacationers from Spain and the United Kingdom make up two-thirds of total demand, Exceltur said. Exceltur's report follows other data that show tourism in Spain expanding even after the March 11 bombings in Madrid, which killed 191 people and injured more than 1,500 on morning rush-hour commuter trains.
